Tumut High School is identified as Category 2 on the Bushfire Register and our primary response is to **evacuate to Tumut TAFE Campus**. We will follow the below steps in the event of a bushfire emergency unless it is not safe to do so, in which case, we will **shelter** in the Multipurpose Centre (MPC)

ACTION

- Call 000*
- ♥ Call Incident Report and Support Hotline 1800 811 523, DEL and monitor Secured Comms*
- Sound alarm and enact bushfire evacuation plan
- ▼ Take Emergency Kit: First aid kit, class lists/rolls, community contacts, visitor sign-in lists, student health plans, medications and Emergency Management Plan
- Switch off gas and electricity mains if possible and safe to do so
- Wardens check buildings and marshal students
- Move to assembly point: Area C (Herbert and Bogong place)
- Conduct roll call of staff, students, visitors, contractors etc.
- ▼ Walk to evacuation refuge: Tumut TAFE, Cnr. Capper and Howick Streets
- Monitor Fires Near Me app, local ABC radio and Secured Comms
- Notify*: Parents via Facebook Skoolbag, Cleaners and Goodes Buses
- Conduct roll call of staff, students, visitors, contractors etc
- Student release to parents recorded in Sentral
- Provide updates to DEL, secured comms and parents/carers
- Await and follow advice of Emergency Services
- Do not re-enter site and/or buildings until advised it is safe to do so (this may include advice from Emergency Services and clearance certificate from AMU If Sheltering:
- Notify as above*
- Move to MPC
- Ensure all school bags and any door mats are indoors
- Relocate bins indoors or centralised out on a grassed area (away from buildings)
- Flammable cabinets are closed and sealed
- Hoses are set up in strategic places and vandal proof tap keys are readily accessible
- Await and follow advice of Emergency Services
- Do not re-enter site and/or buildings until advised it is safe to do so (this may include advice from Emergency Services and clearance certificate from AMU
