Dear Parent/Carer

To celebrate the end of the year and acknowledge student success and achievements, Year 10 students have the opportunity to attend a 3-day, 2-night excursion to **Gerringong** departing **Monday 11th December** and returning on **Wednesday**, 13th **December 2023**.

An itinerary of all activities, required clothing and equipment is included. Students are to wear appropriate neat casual wear with sturdy enclosed shoes for walking.

Transport will be by coach provided by Goodes Coaches departing Tumut High School Bus Shelter at 5.30am on Monday 11th December and returning to school between 9-9.30pm on Wednesday, 13th December 2023. The supervising staff accompanying students on this excursion will be Ms Whyte (Year Adviser), and up to three other staff to be advised. Students will need to bring money to purchase breakfast at South Goulburn along with morning tea, a packed lunch, plenty of snacks and drinking water on the first day. They will also need to have additional money to purchase food while at Jamberoo and dinner on the way home.

Accommodation will be at Chittick Lodge, Gerringong in dormitory style rooms (4 students per room), shared bathroom facilities with dinner and breakfast included, along with a packed lunch on Tuesday, 12th December 2023. Students will need to bring their own fitted sheet, sleeping bag, pillow, bath towel and toiletries. Staff will be located in their own rooms close by the student rooms.

Other activities that students will partake in include a visit to:

- Minnamurra Rainforest Students will view a power point presentation followed by a guided walk through the rich, remnant rainforest teeming with diversity on the beautiful Lyrebird Rainforest Loop walk. The walk is graded as 'easy' with suspension bridges, viewing platforms and interpretive signs along the way. At the conclusion of the guided walk students and staff will continue on along the Minnamurra Falls walk. This walk is graded as 'steep' along a formed track, clearly signposted with occasional steps.
- Kiama Blowhole to Kiama Lighthouse Kiama's famous Blowhole is the largest in the world, and is most spectacular when the swell is running from the south-east. Students will be split into groups of 15 to complete parts of the coastal walk viewing the Blowhole from the public viewing platform, passing the Lighthouse.
- Pines Surfing Academy Students will have the opportunity to have a 2-hour Surfing and a 2-hour Stand Up Paddle (SUP) lesson. Surfing lessons will take place at "The Farm' Killalea State Park with SUP lessons at Trevethan Reserve, The Village Minnamurra.
- Jamberoo Action Park Jamberoo Action Park water rides and attractions are defined as unstructured swimming activities by the NSW Department of Education. Prior to being able access any water rides, students will be required to participate in an aquatic pre-activity Water Survival Challenge to assess your child's aquatic proficiency. At the completion of the Water Survival Challenge your child will be issued with either a blue wrist band allowing them to participate in deep water unstructured activities or a yellow wrist band allowing them to participate in shallow water (waist deep) activities. Staff at Jamberoo Action Park deliver ride specific safety briefings (safety rules for each area) and supervision of all water activities with trained attendants and pool lifeguards.
