Dear Parent/Caregiver

**Year 8** students have the opportunity to attend a **3-day Kianinny Outdoor Education Camp at Tathra** from **Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> to Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> November 2023**. Students will be engaged in a variety of exciting outdoor activities at Kianinny which will encourage team work and help to build better peer relationships. They will also be participating in the following **Structured Aquatic Activities**:

- **Surfing** at Tathra Beach
- Paddle Boarding on the Bega River

A sample program of activities, required clothing and equipment, is included. Kianinny Bush Cottages provide all the necessary equipment for the activities. Students should wear casual clothes on the day of travel.

Transport will be by coach provided by Goode's Coaches, **departing from Tumut High School at 6.30am on Monday**, **20**<sup>th</sup> **and returning at around 7.30pm on Wednesday**, **22**<sup>nd</sup> **November 2023**. Students are to arrive no later than 6.15am to ensure an on-time departure. The supervising teacher will be Mrs Dee (Year Adviser) who will be accompanied by additional staff to be advised.

**The cost of the camp is \$400.00 per student** which covers transport, activities, accommodation and meals (including \$9.09 GST on food). Payment for the camp can be made in full or by instalments in accordance with the following schedule:

- \$100.00 due no later than Thursday, 25<sup>th</sup> May 2023
- \$100.00 due no later than Thursday, 29<sup>th</sup> June 2023
- \$100.00 due no later than Wednesday, 25<sup>th</sup> July 2023
- \$100.00 due not later than Wednesday, 13<sup>th</sup> September

As we are not taking over the counter payments, please make these payments online via our school website <a href="https://tumut-h.schools.nsw.gov.au/">https://tumut-h.schools.nsw.gov.au/</a> under 'Make A Payment' Payments can be made online by either a Debit Card or Credit Card. If you require assistance in doing this please call the office on 6947 0600 as we are happy to guide you through the process.

Please note that luggage is limited to one suitcase/bag plus a sleeping bag and pillow. Students are advised not to bring valuables to the camp as things can be easily damaged or mislaid.

Camp organisers suggest that families check whether their child is up to date with their tetanus vaccination prior to going to camp.

Parents and students are reminded that this is a school activity and students are to behave appropriately. Students need to follow the directions of the supervising teachers and camp staff at all times, following both school and camp expected behaviours.

Under DoE strict COVID 19 Guidelines if your child presents with any cold or flu like symptoms or has an elevated temperature on the day or in the days leading up to that date, they will not be able to attend.

A risk assessment has been prepared for this excursion and the risk has been assessed as "medium". The camp has strict guidelines for the delivery of all activities and firm measures in place to ensure the safety and welfare of students and staff at all times. A copy of the risk assessment is available from the office on request.

Please note that payment indicates your commitment to attend. Due to our transport and accommodation obligations, students who subsequently withdraw may not be eligible for a refund, depending on the individual circumstances.


